

# Core Products International, Inc. Thermal Core Heater Owner's Manual



WARNING: READ OWNER'S MANUAL BEFORE USING THIS HEATER. FAILURE TO FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS AND SAFETY PRECAUTIONS COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY.

**Thermal Core Heaters** are intended to heat moist heat therapy packs (Thermal Core® Packs) to therapeutic temperatures for delivering moist heat therapy to help relieve pain from arthritis, sprains and strains, muscle soreness, and headaches.





**Warning:** To avoid the risk of electric shock, this equipment must only be connected to supply mains with protective earth.

- 1. Read all instructions before using.
- 2. FOR PROFESSIONAL USE ONLY.
- 3. Replenish water daily. NEVER operate Thermal Core Heater with water level lower than 5.08cm, 2" from top of tank.
- 4. Always use handles, knobs, or tongs. Water and steam will be hot.
- 5. To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse unit, cord, or plug in water or other liquid.
- 6. Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before handling, moving, or cleaning.
- 7. Do not operate Thermal Core Heater if damage has occurred. Return appliance to the manufacturer for examination, repair, or electrical or mechanical adjustment. See warranty.
- 8. Do not use accessory attachments not recommended by the manufacturer.
- 9. Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- 10. Do not use outdoors.

## **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS – FOR PROFESSIONAL USE ONLY**

- 1. Place appropriate quantity of Thermal Core packs within the heater.
- 2. Fill the heater with water to a level 5.08cm, 2" below the top of the tank. Distilled water is recommended. If using treated water with a high chlorine level, a dechlorinator may be necessary.
- 3. **IMPORTANT**: Always keep the water level above Thermal Core® packs. Evaporation will reduce the water level. Water must be replenished daily. NEVER operate the Thermal Core Heater with water level lower than 5.08cm, 2" from top of tank.
- 4. Plug cord directly into wall receptacle. Do not use extension cord or plug adapter. These can cause fire, trip, or shock hazard.
- 5. Turn heater on by placing toggle switch in "ON" position.
- 6. Place lid on top of heater.
- 7. Packs will be fully conditioned within 90 minutes.
- 8. Remove the lid and place it upside down in front of the heater for use as a drip tray.
- 9. Using tongs, remove the desired pack, and place it within the appropriate Thermal Core® Pack Cover.
- 10. Immediately replace the cover on the Thermal Core heater.
- 11. Place the covered pack on the patient according to pack manufacturer's instructions.
- 12. DO NOT HANDLE PACK OR WATER WITH UNPROTECTED HANDS. Water and pack will be hot.

The Thermal Core Heater is equipped with two temperature controls. The Control Thermostat automatically heats and maintains the water within the unit at 68.3°–73.8° C, 155°–165° F. If the Control Thermostat fails, the High Limit Thermal Fuse automatically shuts the unit off completely. The Thermal Fuse cannot be reset. Return to manufacturer for servicing.

The pilot light indicates the unit is working, and remains on any time the unit is operating.

If the Thermal Core Packs are not properly heated, the unit should be returned to the manufacturer for servicing.

### **CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:**

The Thermal Core Heater should be thoroughly cleaned weekly.



**CAUTION:** Water in the Thermal Core Heater will be very hot. Wait until unit has cooled before cleaning. Do not immerse unit in water.

DO NOT USE BLEACH OR CHLORINATED CLEANERS ON THIS PRODUCT. BLEACH WILL DESTROY THE STAINLESS STEEL TANK, LID, AND OUTER SHELL, VOIDING THE WARRANTY

- After heating unit has cooled, clean the cover and wire rack only with hot soapy water, or in dishwasher.
   Rinse and dry completely.
- Clean tank with a soft cloth and hot soapy water.
- If limescale has developed in the unit, wipe with a soft cloth soaked in distilled white vinegar. Then thoroughly rinse with hot soapy water.
- Use of steel wool or abrasive cleaners/scouring powders will scratch or damage the stainless steel tank.
- Thoroughly rinse the interior of the unit before refilling.


